# R. Umadevi: The third Indian woman to ever win World Ladies Billiards Championship.

She was the World Ladies Billiards Champion 2012, and surely most of you mustn't have heard about her until now. She is only the third Indian woman after Anuja Thakur and Chitra Magimairaj to win this title. The 47-year-old Bengaluru resident started her career in her 30s, with a regular job of senior typist with Karnataka State Horticulture department and despite of all financial failures, she became the world champion in 2012.

#### Dr. Ravindra Koelhe: Dedicated 26 years of his life to tribal health services.

Dr. Koelhe has been working in the tribal areas of Maharashtra as a community doctor and charges Rs. 2 for the first consultation and Rs. 1 for the second. When he arrived at Melghat, the infant mortality rate was close to 200 per 1,000 babies, now the count is 60. It has been 26 years now and Koelhe still continues to serve these people, half of which he confirms still have no clue about clothing. It was to serve the village of Melghat that Koelhe earned a MD in preventive and social medicine.



## Arunima Sinha: World's first female amputee to climb the Mt. Everest. She was thrown out of a moving train by a bunch of thieves.

A former national volleyball and football player, Arunima was thrown out of a moving train by a couple of perverts who tried to rob her but eventually failed. She fell on a parallel track and was immediately run over by a passing train and lost her leg. But her disability didn't restrain her to achieve a feat that only a few have achieved thus far, in the whole wide world. She reached the summit of Mount Everest at 10:55 am on 21 May 2013 and became the only one in doing so.

## Rajesh Kumar Sharma: Grocery stone owner who offers free education to New Delhi's slum children under a metro bridge.

This grocery shop owner founded a free school for slum children under a metro bridge, despite having no background in teaching. Rajesh takes out 2 hours every day from his schedule to teach these impoverished slum children. Staring from the very basics of literacy, he goes on to prepare the children for admission to government schools. He started with approximately 140 students, and 70 of them are in government schools now. He is often assisted Laxmi Chandra, a postgraduate who teaches science.



#### Bunker Roy: The founder of the Barefoot College movement.

The founder of the Barefoot College movement which stands for education, skill development, health, drinking water, women empowerment and electrification through solar power for the upliftment of rural people. One of the shining examples of his endeavour is the village of Tilonia. It produces its own electricity via solar panels, manufactures its own lightning equipment and has its own school and a medical centre. He was chosen as one of the 100 most influential people in the world by TIME magazine in 2010.

#### Chitresh Tatha: Youngest athlete ever to participate in Asia Games 2014.

A class VII student, Chitresh Tatha from Chennai is India's youngest athlete ever to participate at the 2014 Asian Games being held in Incheon, South Korea. At a tender age of 12, this little sailor has won championships across Ireland, France, UK, Malaysia, Turkey, the Netherlands, Bahrain and Malta.

### YOUR AADHAR AWAITS YOU AT THE POST OFFICE!

The Unique Identification Authority of India, under the Government of India, is leaving no stone unturned to ensure that every Indian citizen is linked to Aadhar. In order to improve accessibility, Aadhar has taken the help of the service with the farthest reach—India Post.

Now, Aadhar enrolment centres have been set up in more than 6,500 post offices. It will soon open in over 13,000 post offices across the country. The address and location of the nearest one can be received just by accessing uidai.gov.in or calling 1947 (toll free). The services are not just limited to enrolment, but also updating of services. Though the Aadhar enrolment services are completely free, updating Aadhar details will cost a fee of Rs. 29.50 (inclusive of taxes).

Even if you have got your Aadhar done from a different state, you can get it updated from anywhere in India if you have supporting documents. The list of required supporting documents is available at uidai.gov.in.

Anyone from a new born to elderly can enrol for Aadhar from any centre in the country. A child's Aadhar is linked to the Aadhar of one of the parents, based on Proof of Relationship documents such as Birth Certificate, Passport etc. Biometrics of a child needs to be mandatorily updated at age 5 and then again at 15 years of age. This update is free of cost.

Physical presence at the Aadharis an essential requirement.

### **FEI DUNIYA**



Apart from being the capital of Uruguay, Montevideo is significant for handling the country's foreign trade, including exports of meat, hides, and wool through its port situated at the shores of the Rio de la Plata estuary. Port of Montevideo consists of wool-processing plants, manufacturing units for textiles, matches, soaps, shoes and clothing. Cement works, oil refineries, electric power system are other industries settled in this city.

The city began as a Spanish military base. When the Spanish Crown granted the Port of Montevideo the right to be the region's only slave port, the Port of Montevideo witnessed the first economic boom. In 1776, it became Spain's naval base, in 1828 it was declared as the capital of Uruguay.

The Port has access to interior lands in facilitated by river, road and rail with Brazil, Paraguay, Argentina and Bolivia. The port's access channel has two sections, one to the south that is 9 kms long and one to the west-southwest that is 15 kms long.

The port is protected by two breakwaters. The west breakwater is 1300 meters long and protects the southwest of the port, and thee east breakwater is 900 meters long that protects the port from winds from the south and southeast. There is also a 200-hectare anchorage area outside the port.

Port volumes handled at Montevideo have more than doubled over the past nine years.

Sridevi started her career at a very early age in 1967 as a child artiste in a Tamil movie 'Kandhan Karunai'. Regarded as Indian cinema's biggest female superstar, she was the recipient of two Filmfare Awards and three Filmfare Awards South. In 2013, the Government of India awarded Sridevi the Padma Shri, the country's fourth highest civilian accolade for her contributions to the entertainment industry. Honourary awards were also conferred on her by the state governments of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Kerala. Sridevi was also voted 'India's Greatest Actress in 100 Years' in a CNN-IBN national poll conducted in 2013 on the occasion of the centenary of Indian cinema.

#### RIP 8 January 1942 - 14 March 2018

Stephen Hawking was regarded as one of the most brilliant theoretical physicists in history. His work on the origins and structure of the universe, from the Big Bang to black holes, revolutionized the field, while his best-selling books have appealed to readers who may not have Hawking's scientific background. He is the recipient of many accolades, including Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest civilian award in the United States.
