"I want a decisive and unanimous answer!" he shouted.

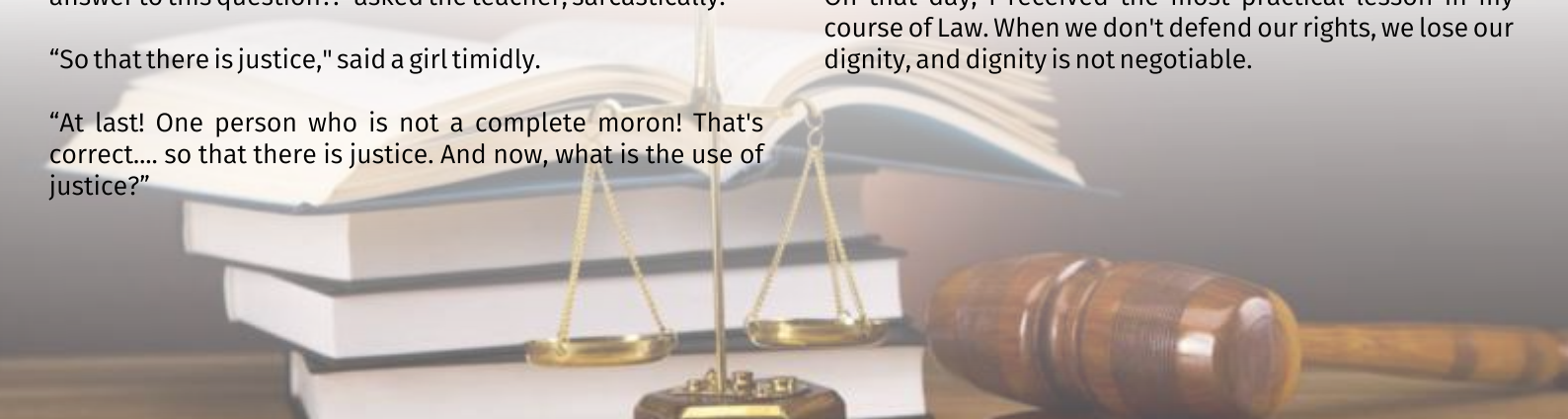
"No!" we all replied in unison.

If power ensures security, then VIPs should walk unguarded.

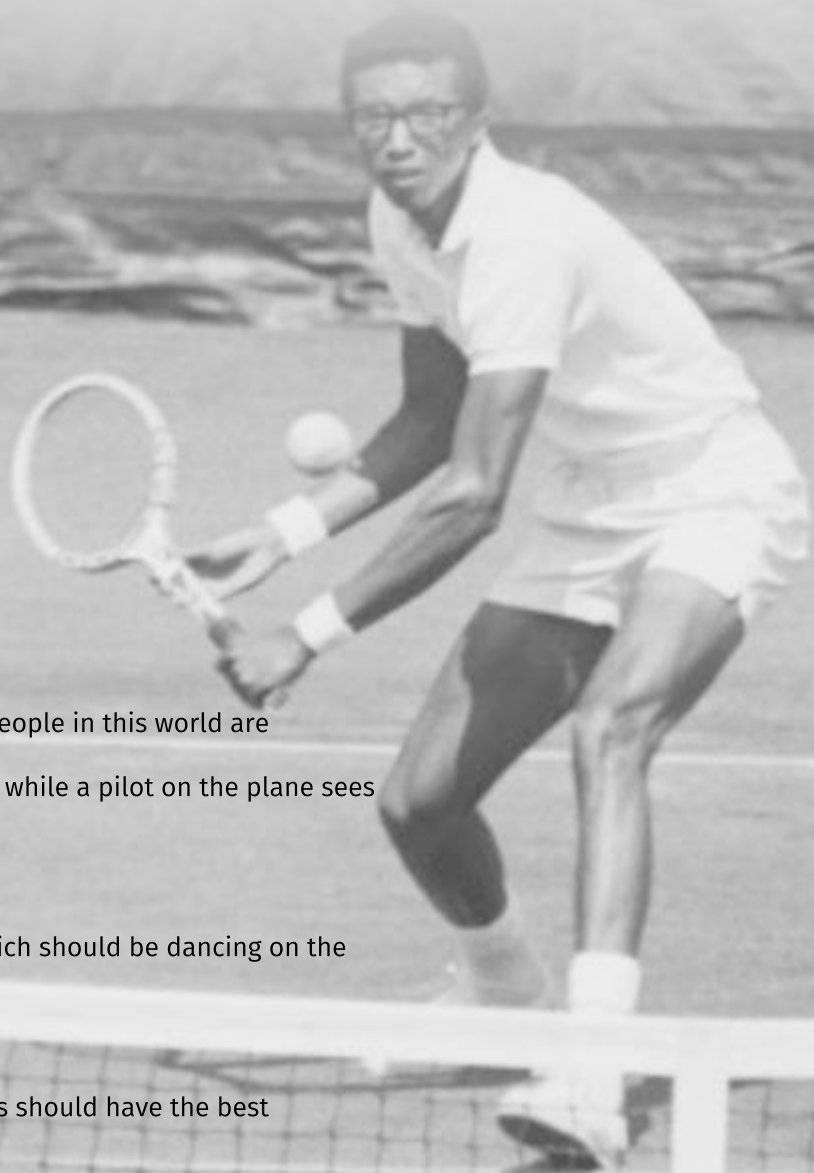
But those who live simply, sleep soundly

# T N SESHAN

**Tirunellai Narayana Iyer Seshan (15 December 1932 – 10 November 2019)** was an Indian civil servant who served with the Indian Administrative Service.

He was appointed the 10th Chief Election Commissioner of India (1990–96) and became known for election reforms. He won the Ramon Magsaysay Award for government service in 1996.

## Early Life

Mr Seshan was born on 15 December 1932 in Palghat (Palakkad). He was youngest of six siblings and his father was a lawyer in a district court. He passed the Indian Administrative Service exam in 1954 and joined as a trainee of 1955 Tamil Nadu cadre

## Personal Life

He was married to Jayalakshmi Seshan from 1959 until her death in March 2018. He knew several languages including Tamil, Malayalam, Sanskrit, English, Hindi, Kannada, Marathi and Gujarati.

## Election Commission of India

He was appointed the 10th Chief Election Commissioner and had served from 12 December 1990 to 11 December 1996.

He became best known for his election reforms such as enforcement of election code of conduct, Voter IDs for all eligible voters, limit on election candidates' expenditure, appointing election officials from states other than the one facing polls.

During the 1993 Indian general elections, due to his reforms, 1488 candidates were disqualified for three years for failing to submit their expenditure accounts. In 1992, the Election Commission cancelled elections in Bihar and Punjab due to electoral issues.

## Last Moments

He breathed his last at his home in Chennai on 10th November 2019.
