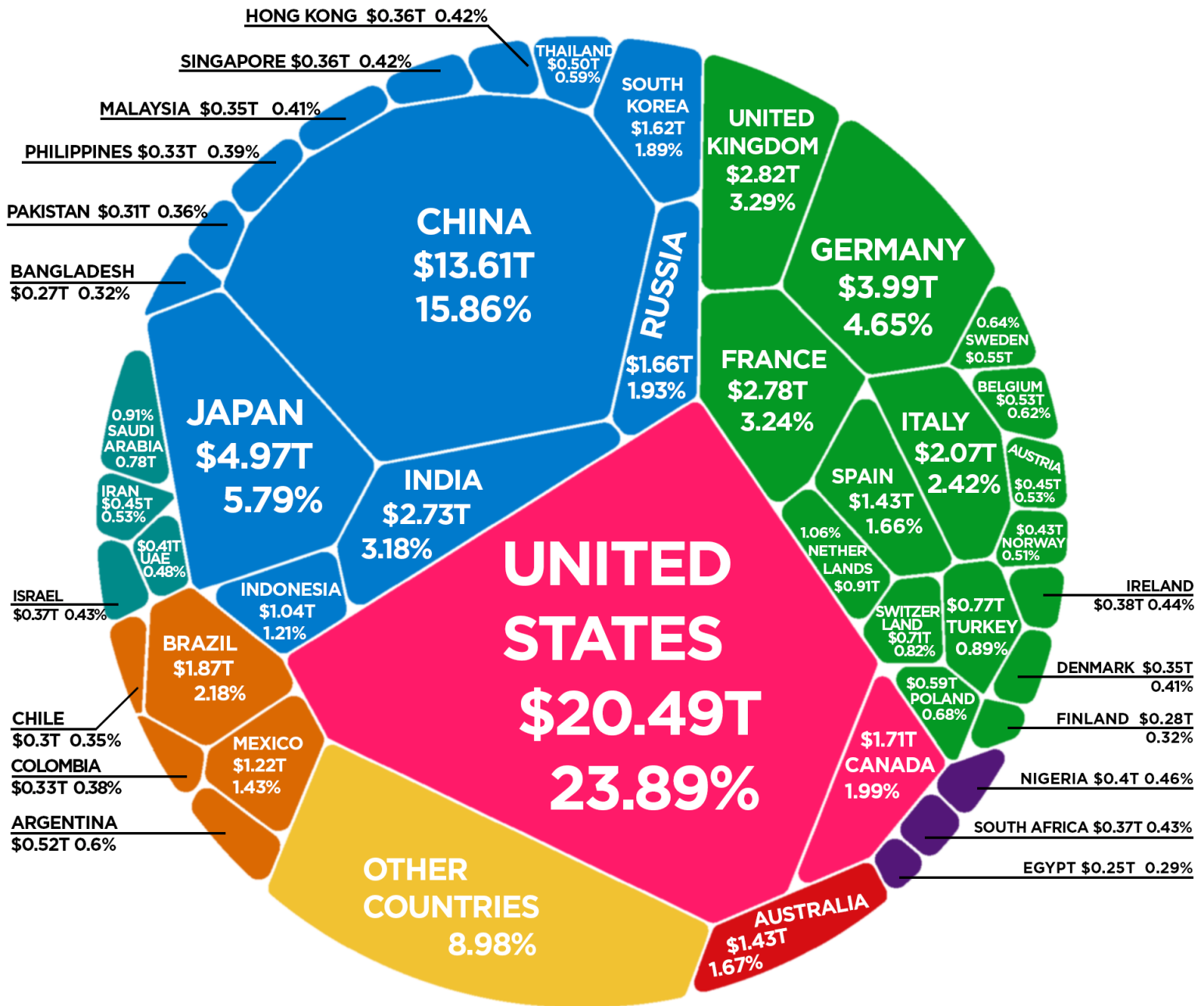


We encourage you to start with any of these and give it a go. Because a seven figure in your savings account looks much better than the idle Jordans in your rack.
