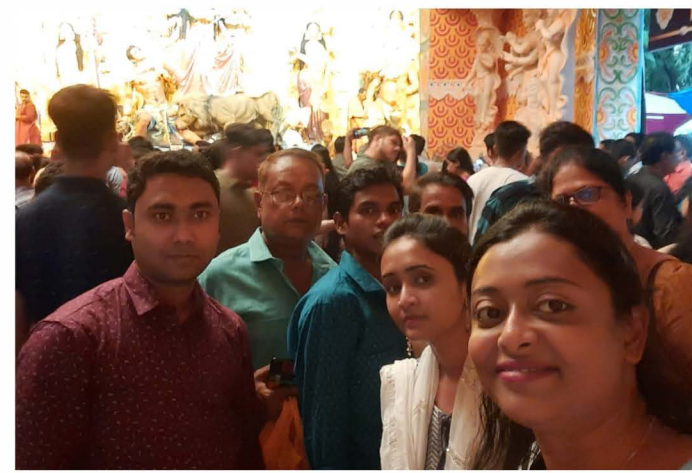
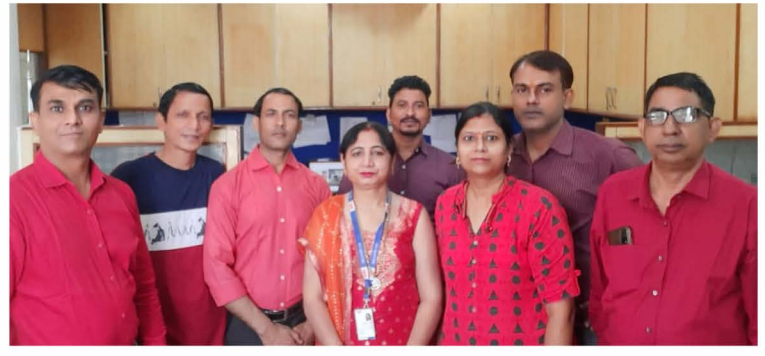

The king also came to know from the prison guard there, that this was the only prisoner who behaved well in the prison. The king immediately ordered his release.

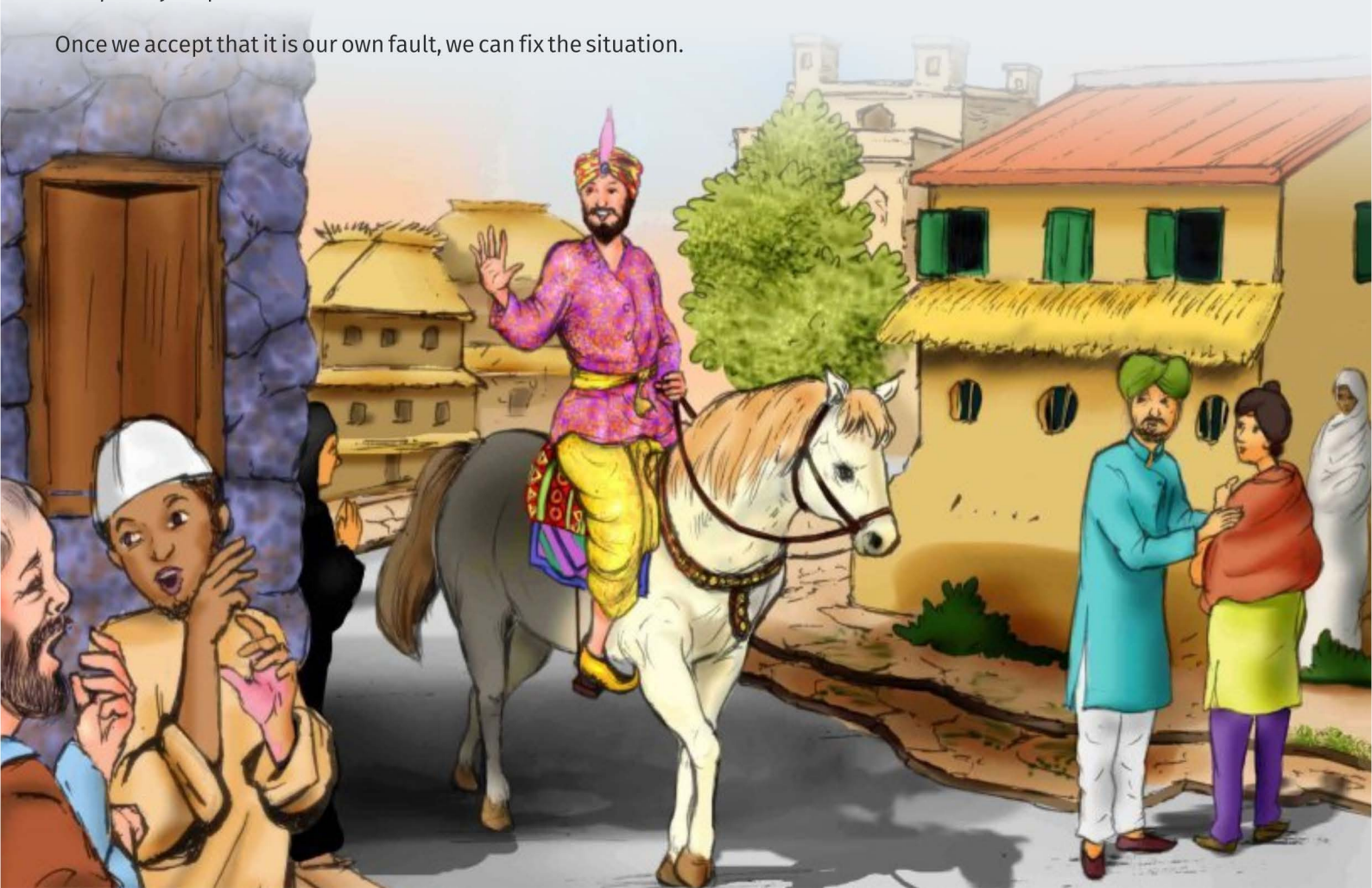
This short story has revealed a deep secret.

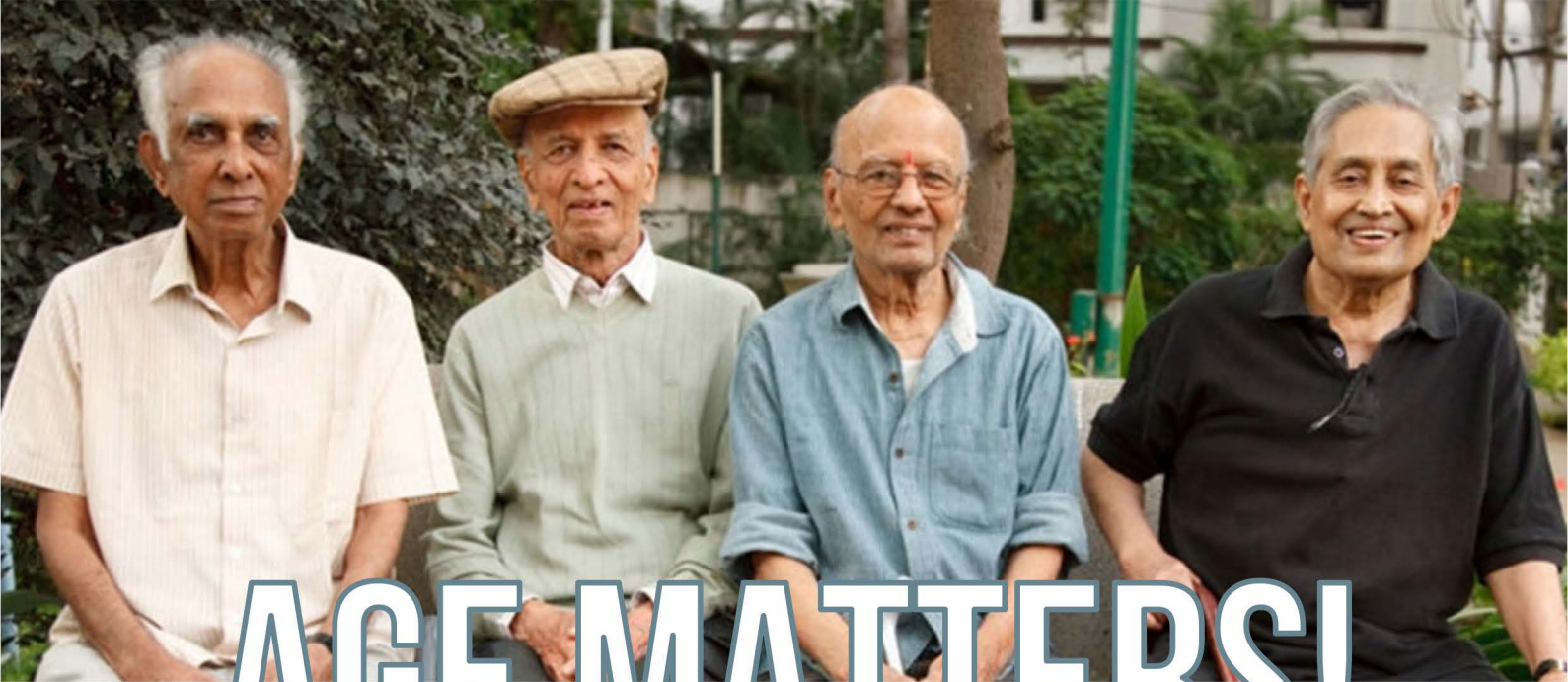
Hence, we are not ready to accept responsibility and keep blaming many other factors.

Legend has it that the famous jeweler Charles Lewis Tiffany knew that John Pierpont Morgan (JPMorgan), had a thing for necktie pins.

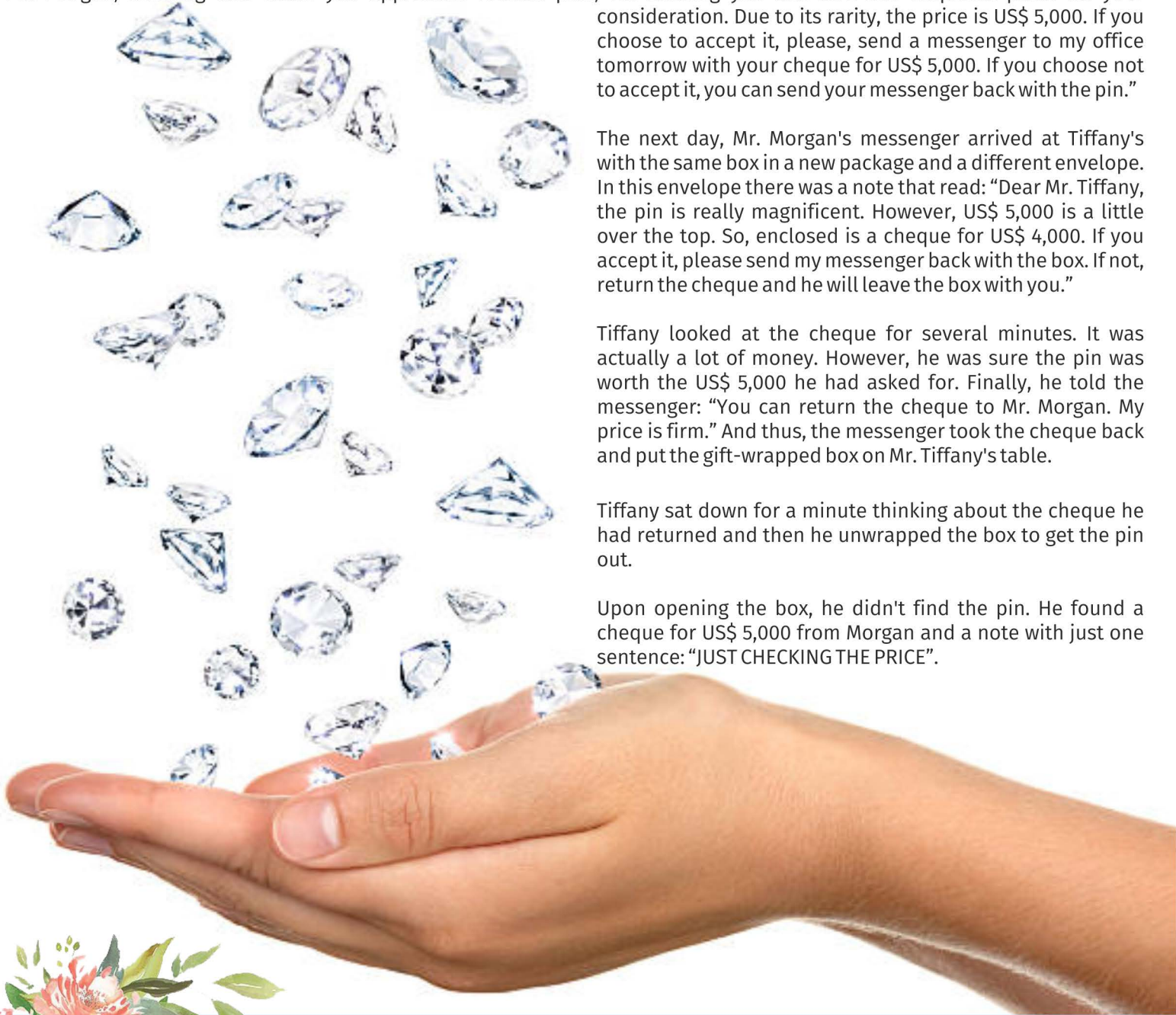

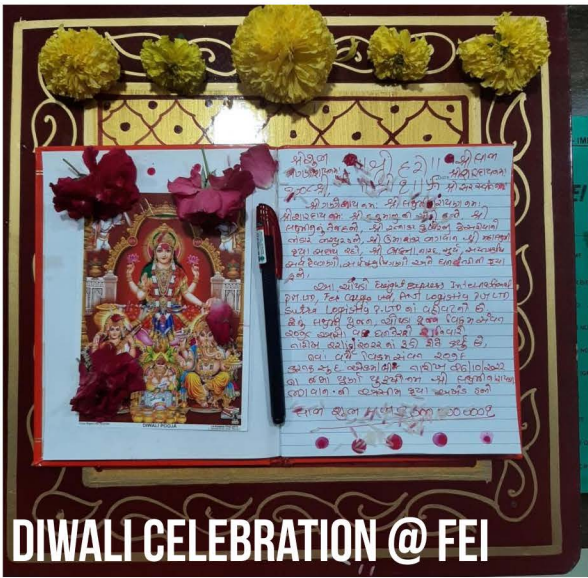
