Protecting and reforming is tougher than exposing and expelling!!

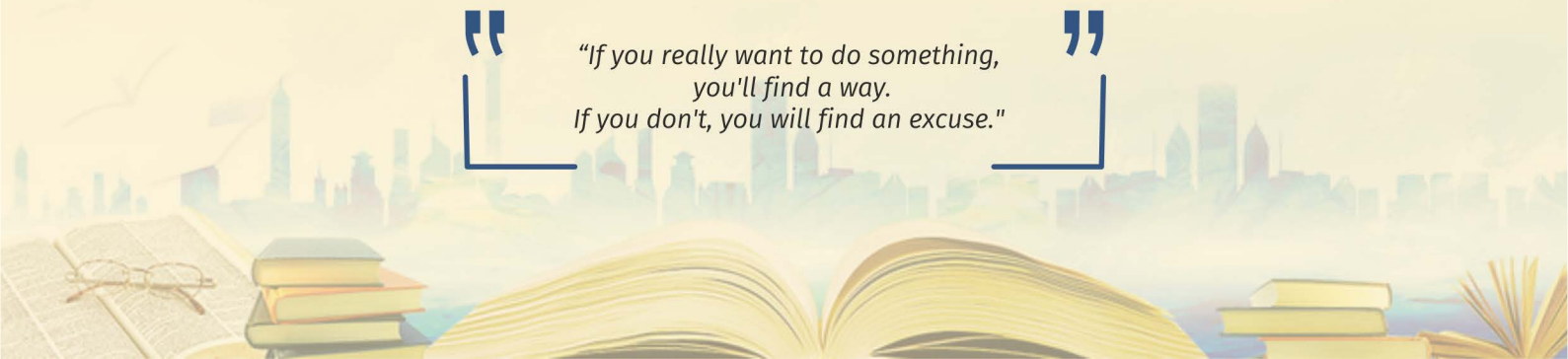

If Duryodhana wins the war you will get a lot of credit. What do I get if Dharmaraja wins the war? Only the blame for the war and all related problems...

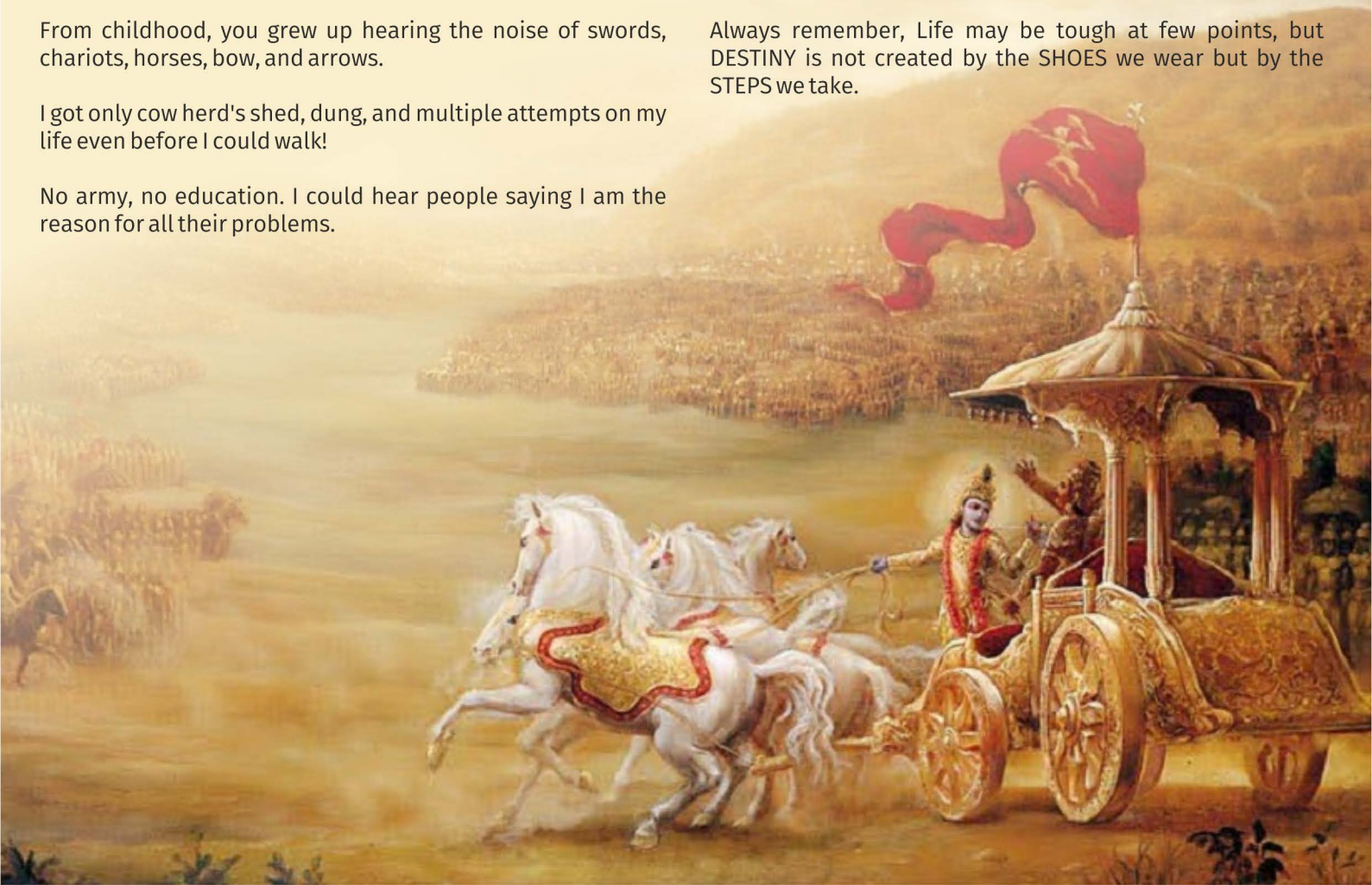
Remember one thing, Karna. Everybody has challenges in life to face.

"The vendor said, 'Sir, don't you think that by doing so you won't be able to match my help?'

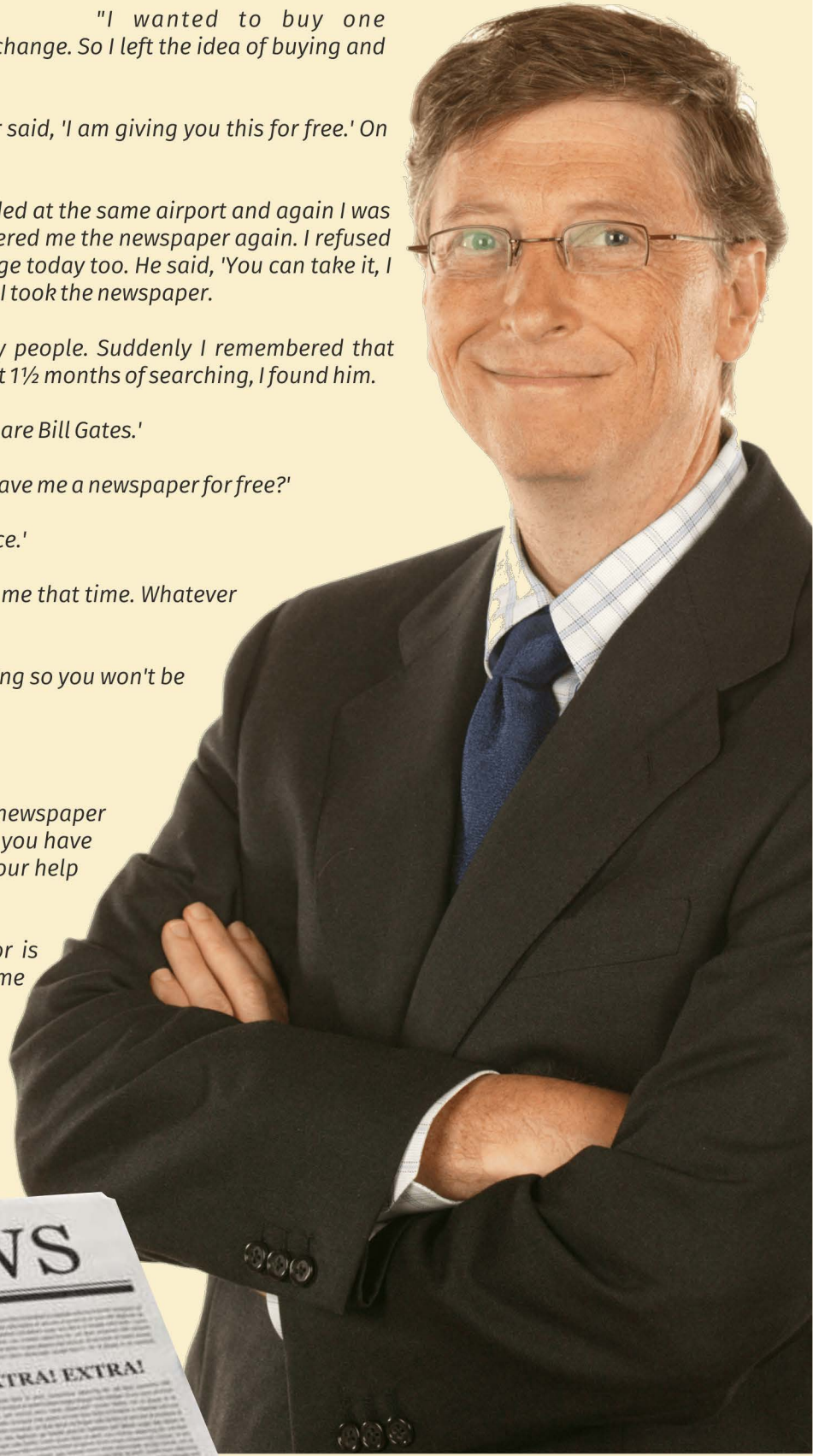
"I asked, 'Why?'

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE RARE INCIDENTS THAT HAPPENED IN

Cricket?

Shoaib Malik and Moises Henriques are the only players in history, who got dismissed on duck twice in a single t20 match.

Once in the regular innings, and another duck in super over.

Umar Akmal is the only player in history, who got dismissed thrice in a span of 24 hours.

In 1946, during a first class match, a bowler bowled 14 deliveries in an over without bowling any wide or no ball. Actually the umpire forgot to count his deliveries.

The longest six hit was 1060 km. This match was being played in Johannesburg, and the ball landed on a train outside ground. Until the ball was recovered, train had reached Port Elizabeth.

Abdul Razzaq is the only player in history to have batted on all 11 positions in the batting order.

Anil Kumble and Jim Laker are the only players in history who took 10 wickets in an innings of a test.

Jonty Rhodes is the only player in history who won the MAN OF THE MATCH award, without even being included in the playing eleven. He was playing as a substitute fielder, and managed to take 7 catches.

SACHIN RAMESH TENDULKAR is the only Indian player who played for Pakistan. In 1987, during an international match, he served as a substitute fielder for Pakistan.

India is currently the only country who has won the 60, 50 and 20 over world cups. 60 over in 1983, 20 over in 2007 and 50 over in 2011.

Mahela Jayawardene is the only player in history who had scored century in semi-final and final of World cup.

Chris Gayle is the only player in history who hit a sixer on the very 1st ball of a test match.

In 2000, 4 innings were played in a single day of a test match between England vs West Indies.

West Indies is currently the only team in history, who won both editions of World Cup twice. (50 over & 20 over). 50 over 1975, 1979 and 20 over 2012, 2016.
